



Terms and Conditions

Completion of the Rezvan Foundation Scholarship Application constitutes acceptance of the following terms (by Applicant or Parent / Guardian if Applicant is under 18 years old):

1. **Availability of Scholarship Funds:** The Rezvan Foundation is a non-profit organization, heavily dependant on fundraising. Funding of awarded scholarships, including annual renewals of awarded scholarships, is conditioned upon the availability of funds as determined by the Rezvan Foundation Board. In light of this, and to be prudent, scholarship awardees, should not rely on full funding, but should reasonably expect receipt of awarded scholarship funds to the extent those funds are available as determined by the Board, and to the extent all applicable requirements are met.
2. **Amount and use of Scholarship Funds:** The amount of scholarship awarded will vary based on the university the scholarship recipient attends, as well as any other grants, awards, or financial aid the recipient receives, and shall be determined by the Rezvan Foundation Board. The scholarship award may, but need not, be renewed annually by the Rezvan Foundation Board. If the scholarship is renewed, the amount awarded may vary year to year, again based on other grants, awards, or aid; subject to availability; and for other reasons in the Board's discretion. Scholarship funds are only intended for, and shall only be used to pay general and instructional fees owed to the four year accredited university that the scholarship recipient attends.
3. **Duration of Scholarship:** No person shall be granted a scholarship for more than five academic years total, or over the course of more than six years.
4. **Criteria for Receipt of Scholarship Funds:** The scholarship awardee:
 - Is enrolled and in good standing at a four year accredited university, or is in her / his final year of high school, accepted to a four year accredited university, and will begin university in the academic year immediately following high school graduation.
 - Maintains an annual 3.0 GPA or higher at the four year university s/he attends
 - Has no disciplinary record (academic or criminal)
 - Abides by the Rezvan Foundation Terms and Conditions and Rezvan Foundation Guidelines, including as they may vary over time.
5. **Return of Scholarship Funds:** A Rezvan Foundation Scholarship awardee agrees to return any awarded funds if s/he misuses scholarship funds (§2) or makes any knowing misstatement to the Rezvan Foundation.
6. **Use of your name, likeness, personal information.** Rezvan Foundation may use,

exploit, adapt, modify, reproduce, distribute, publicly perform and display, in any form now known or later developed, applicants' or scholarship awardees' words, images, visual likenesses, names and/or voices (each and collectively, the "Personal Information"). You hereby release Rezvan Foundation including, its Board and employees, from any and all claims, now or in the future, for invasion of privacy, right of publicity, copyright infringement, defamation or any other cause of action arising out of the use, exploitation, reproduction, adaptation, distribution, broadcast, performance or display of the Personal Information. You further waive any right to inspect or to approve anything that may be created using the Personal Information and waive any claim with respect to the eventual use to which the Personal Information may be applied.

7. **Rezvan Foundation Terms and Rezvan Foundation Guidelines Subject to Change.** Rezvan Foundation Terms and Guidelines may change over time. If you are a scholarship recipient, your acceptance or use of any scholarship funds constitutes your acceptance of the then-current Terms and Guidelines as soon as you are 18 years of age or older.
